Born in 1964 in West Chiltington, Sussex, Andrew was educated at Haberdashers' Aske's School in Elstree before attending Oxford University to read for a BA in Modern History. He later received a PhD in Military History from Leeds University.

Andrew has spent his career in manufacturing, having started his own business in Scunthorpe in 1989 producing packaging for the food industry. He subsequently sold his company to BPI plc in 1994, after which he was appointed to a number of general management positions within the group before taking over as CEO in 2018. In the course of his career Andrew has lived and worked in Italy and spent time managing businesses in continental Europe, North America and China. Much of Andrew's career has been involved in plastic recycling and sustainability.

Between 2008 and 2020 Andrew served as a Lay Canon on the Chapter of York Minster and as Canon Treasurer. Andrew continues to sit on York Minster's Finance Committee.

Andrew has been married to Kate since 1987 and they have two sons, Alex and Nick. They moved from East Yorkshire to North Yorkshire in 1995.
